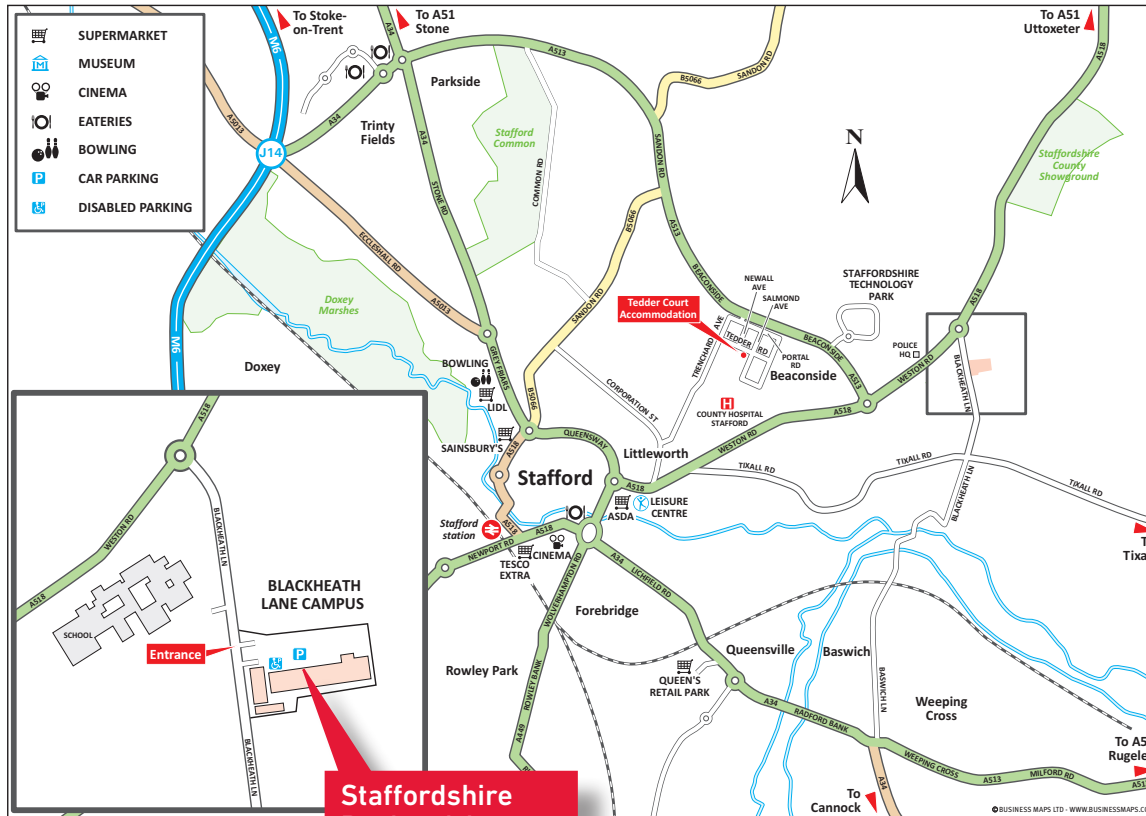

Finding the Staffordshire Regional Access Centre

The Centre of Excellence in Healthcare is located on Blackheath Lane

Enter the building through the main Centre of Excellence entrance. On your left is the main Information Point where you will be directed to the Staffordshire Regional Access Centre for your appointment.

Travelling by car

ST18 0YB

*Please note that this postcode is for guidance only and may not take you to the precise point of entry onto the campus.

Parking is available purely on a first come, first served basis and can be extremely busy at peak times. Visitors must display a visitor permit on their vehicle dashboard. Contact the Staffordshire Regional Access Centre with your car registration details so that a Permit can be emailed to you for you to print out prior to your appointment.

From the M6

1. Leave the M6 motorway at Junction 14 (Stafford North)
2. Follow signs for MOD Stafford
3. Continue straight on through the first roundabout onto the A513 Beaconside and pass the main entrance to the MOD Stafford on your left.
4. At the next roundabout, take the first exit onto the A518.

5. At the next roundabout take the third exit (signposted Crematorium, Baswich, Great Haywood, Little Haywood)
6. The entrance to the Centre of Excellence at Blackheath Lane is the next left.

From the East and A50

1. Via Uttoxeter from the A50, take the A518 to Stafford.
2. Pass the County Showground on your left.
3. At the next roundabout take the turn left (signposted Crematorium, Baswich, Great Haywood, Lit Haywood)
4. The entrance to the Centre of Excellence at Blackheath Lane is the next left.

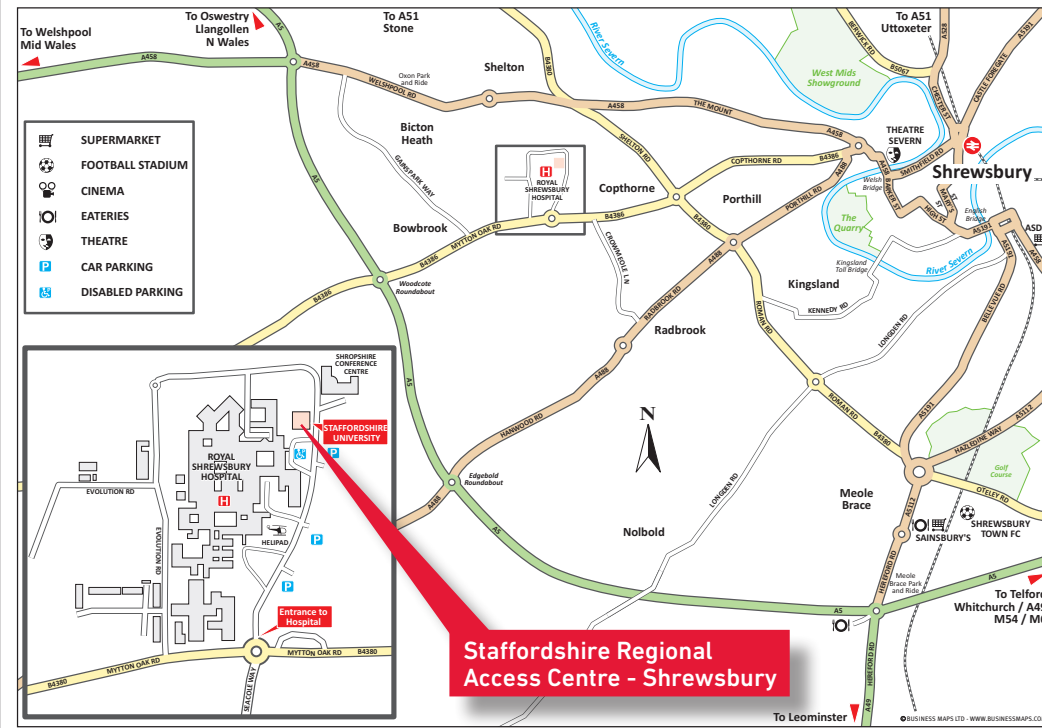
Travelling by rail

Stafford railway station is situated near the town centre, about a mile and a half from the campus. There is a taxi rank outside the railway station and a frequent bus service (74/75 Arriva) which stops within a 20-minute walk of the Centre of Excellence Stafford.

Finding the Staffordshire Regional Access Centre

The Staffordshire Regional Access Centre is located within the Staffordshire University Faculty of Health Sciences building at the

Royal Shrewsbury Hospital

On arrival, go through the main doors to the Information Point where you will be directed to the Staffordshire Regional Access Centre for your appointment.

Travelling by car

From the East (Birmingham M6): Join the M54 at Junction 10a (sign posted North and Mid Wales/Telford). The M54 becomes the A5. At the first roundabout take the 1st exit (sign posted North Wales/Oswestry). Stay on the A5 at the next 3 roundabouts. At roundabout (Junction with B4386) take 3rd exit on to B4386 (signposted Shrewsbury). The Royal Shrewsbury Hospital is 0.8 miles on the left.

From the North (Chester A483): Follow the A483 past Wrexham, to Oswestry. At roundabout (Junction with A5) take the 1st exit on to A5 (signposted Shrewsbury). Remain on the A5 at the next roundabouts. At roundabout (Junction with B4386) take 1st exit on to B4386 (signposted Shrewsbury). The Royal Shrewsbury Hospital is 0.8 miles on the left.

From the West (Welshpool (Y-Trallwng) A458): At roundabout (junction with A5) take 3rd exit on to A5. At next roundabout (Junction with B4386) take 1st exit on to B4386 (signposted Shrewsbury). Royal Shrewsbury Hospital is 0.8 miles on the left.

Parking

- There is a tiered charging structure offering a range of rates for different lengths of stay.
- Once your visit is complete, you can pay for your parking at one of the on-site machines located at the exits of the hospital using cash, debit or credit card.
- You can also pay online after you get home by logging on to www.sathparking.co.uk. You must log on to pay by midnight on the day of your departure from the hospital site.
- The hospital can be very busy, so please allow plenty of time before your appointment to park.
- The car parks are managed by CP Plus. Please talk to the CP Plus Car Parking Attendants if you are having difficulty finding a space.

Travelling by bus

The bus station is situated in the centre of Shrewsbury. The No.1 Arriva Bus runs a frequent bus service to the hospital's main site.

Travelling by rail

Shrewsbury station is situated in the centre of Shrewsbury, and is approximately 15-20 minutes drive from the hospital. Taxis are available from outside the station and the bus station is within walking distance.
