

The Children's University in Stoke-on-Trent

With initial funding from the National Children's University and the support of Staffordshire University, the Children's University in Stoke was established in March 2009.

The underlying principle of the Children's University is to ensure that children, between the ages of 7 – 14 years, can choose to take part in 'quality' out of school hours learning. Providers of out of school hours learning can undergo Children's University 'validation'

which guarantees the quality of the activities they make available. Providers may be located in schools or elsewhere within the community. For example, the National Children's University are closely affiliated to the Royal Shakespeare Company and Playing for Success.
