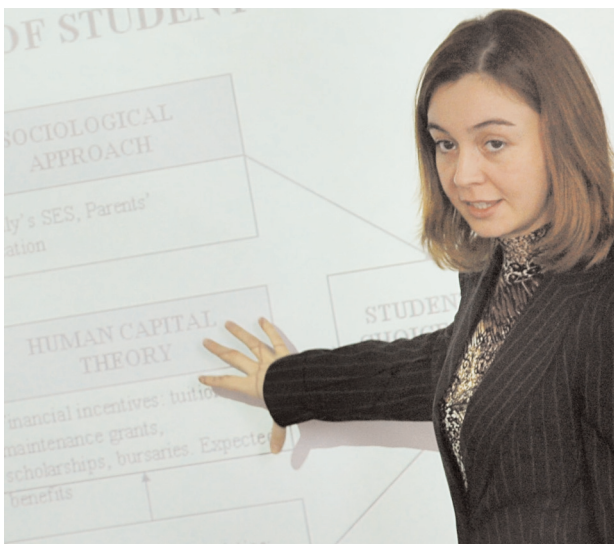
### MSc Economics for Business Analysis (EBA)



#### Overview of the Course

The MSc ECONOMICS FOR BUSINESS ANALYSIS (EBA) is a rigorous postgraduate Economics Award. The specific focus of the MSc EBA is the investigation of business from the viewpoint of the discipline of economics and the material is specifically chosen with this in mind.

This award is focused on the economic analysis of business. It covers microeconomics, macroeconomics and econometrics at an advanced level and from the viewpoint of your firm. In addition, it covers personnel economics, business finance and accounting to enhance your knowledge of other dimensions of business analysis. Research Methods for Economics is taught throughout the course and culminates in a masters dissertation in Business Analysis. This Award has been reviewed by the Quality Assurance Agency and received a ranking of "Excellent" with a mark of 24 out of 24. It is also included in the UK Government's Chevening programme, offering scholarships to students from Central and Eastern Europe.



The MSc responds to changes in the economic environment, particularly those associated with business analysis, forecasting and integration by providing professional training for economics and business graduates with interests and career intentions in banking, finance and insurance as well as government.

#### How long does the course last?

Normally thirteen months.

#### When can I start?

September each year.

#### Entry Requirements

At least a 2:2 UK Honours degree or equivalent in an economics related discipline is required; and at least IELTS 6.0 or equivalent.



#### Where would I be studying?

Both the MSc EBA and the MA EITEI are based on the Stoke-on-Trent campus in Staffordshire. The MA EITEI has study periods in Antwerp and Prague.
