



## Section G: Parent(s) and Legal Guardians Bank Account:

- 1. Do you have an original signed permission letter from your parent or parents stating your relationship to them, and that they are happy to support you during your UK studies?**

*If the bank account is in both parents' names, the permission letter must be signed by both parents showing they both agree to supporting you in your studies.*

**Yes** – Please continue to 2.

**No** – The UKVI will not accept a bank statement or bank letter from your parents without a supporting permission letter from them stating they give permission for you to use the funds.

- 2. Do you have your original birth certificate which names you and your parents?**

**Yes** – Please continue to 3.

**No** – Your original birth certificate showing your relationship to your parents is required. Without this the UKVI will reject your financial documents.

- 3. Is the birth certificate written in English or do you have an official translation of it?**

**Yes** – If you have met these requirements, along with the requirements in Section A, B or C, you are good to go!

**No** – You are required to obtain an official translation of this document. The translation must specify:

- A confirmation from the translator that it is an accurate translation of the original document.
- The date the translation was done.
- The translators full name, their signature, and their contact details.
