He is also Chairman of the trustees of the Carbon Disclosure Project, WCMC 2000 and is Chairman of the Green Fiscal Commission.

Robert's community activities include being Chairman of the Governors of Sedbergh School and a Trustee of Baynards Zambia Trust.
