CENTRE FOR HEALTH INNOVATION

The building has transformed the way we deliver courses to healthcare students. Now you can experience the amazing equipment for yourself at today's Open Day.

The hands-on facilities include one of the world's largest 'simmersive' suites – a training space where incredibly realistic backdrops are projected onto three whole walls. You can be placed at the scene of a road accident, with passing cars, street lights and noise. And you can even extricate a casualty from a vehicle parked inside the room.

The spaces enable you to learn in a safe environment before working

in real-life healthcare settings, with a debriefing room for class discussions.

We also use other clinical simulation suites to bring your training to life, including a hospital ward, operating theatre and emergency department. If you're a student paramedic, you'll have access to our training ambulance too.

What's more, you'll be taught by academics who come from a variety of specialist backgrounds, and are passionate about the future of healthcare.

We are leading the way as one of the largest providers of higher and degree apprenticeships in England. Our provision was judged as 'good' by Ofsted at our last full inspection.

As an apprentice, you have a full-time role with your employer and spend regular periods doing 'off-the-job' training with the University. It means you can achieve a university degree by learning while you work. We also offer progression routes, which can take you from Level 4 right through to Level 7.

What is an apprenticeship?

An apprenticeship is a job with approved training to industry standards. At the end of the apprenticeship, you will have an assessment to ensure you meet the required skills and knowledge.

How do they work?

Apprentices must spend an average of at least six hours a week doing off-the-job training. This can also cover shadowing, mentoring, industry visits and attending competitions. You have on-the-job training as well, where you develop specific workplace skills and are supported by a mentor.

We predominantly follow a blended learning model, where apprentices spend some face-to-face time on campus followed by webinars and planned practice learning.

Who are they for?

Employers can offer apprenticeships to new recruits or use them to grow talent from their existing workforce. Our Apprenticeships Team will work with an employer and a prospective apprentice to assess eligibility for the apprenticeship.

ROUTES INTO STUDY

We're here to support your education journey all the way through to graduation and a successful career.

UNDER-

GRADUATE

From taking a first degree to exploring postgraduate options, these are the main traditional routes to studying at University of Staffordshire. But it's always worth speaking with our teams to explore other routes too, which take into account any experience and skills you may have in your chosen field.



1. A-LEVELS / T-LEVELS

The grades you'll need will depend on the course you want to study. You'll find the UCAS tariff entry requirements on the individual course page of our website.

2. BTEC

Many students join us with Level 3 BTECs. If you have a BTEC Level 5 or 6, you may go straight onto the second or third year of a degree.

3. STEP UP TO HE

Step Up to HE is a free 10-week course that gives you a taste of what it's like to study at university. To find out more, visit:

4. ACCESS TO HE DIPLOMA

Access to HE courses are offered in a variety of subjects at Level 3.

1. DIRECT

If you studied at undergraduate level and have been in industry, or want to switch career paths, you can apply direct. This will depend on previous qualifications or work experience.

2. PROGRESSION

Your higher education journey can continue after you graduate. If you take your undergraduate degree with us, you may qualify for an alumni discount.

3. STEP UP

If you are a mature student who graduated some time ago or a professional without a degree, you can apply via our step up programme.
