

CLEANING SCHEDULE



Accommodation

It's everyone's responsibility to make sure your bedrooms and shared spaces are kept clean and tidy. Respecting your flatmates allows everyone to live together in a safe, healthy and clean environment.

Cleaning materials have been provided in all shared areas for you to use and keep your own areas clean. Make sure to clean up after yourselves each time you use any shared kitchen and bathroom areas.

Please empty your own rubbish and place it in one of the large bins in the external bin stores daily. Rubbish bags are not provided.



Housekeeping cleaning will take place once a week. This will be general cleaning of the communal areas.



Additional cleaners are being implemented this year due to COVID-19. They will be cleaning frequent touch point areas within blocks daily and within flats weekly.



Green - no action needed

6 consecutive greens will result in a flat treat

Amber - action required

Flat meeting, improvement notices and possible disciplinary action

Red - urgent action required

Flat meeting, final notices served, leading to formal disciplinary action

Communal area checks will be completed once a week to help and guide residents with their own cleaning. Flats will then be given either a green, amber or red rating.

If any shared areas are amber or red, improvement notices will be served. If improvements are not made, further action may be taken.
