Deadlines

If you are selected for this opportunity by the Go Abroad team at University of Staffordshire, your exchange application to Breda University will need to be submitted as follows:

Application deadline Semester 1 – 16th May

Application deadline Semester 2 – 23rd October

Accommodation

Unfortunately, Breda University of Applied Sciences has no campus or student rooms of its own and, therefore, it will be your own responsibility to find accommodation in Breda. Rental prices for a student room in Breda vary from €450 to €700+ per month.

Most students find their rooms through Facebook groups, Klikvoorkamers (Click for Rooms) or with a local commercial company. Don't wait—check the housing manual and begin your search immediately to avoid missing out on available options!

BUas would like to help international students find accommodation in Breda and its surroundings. Therefore, they have a housing buddy for the summer months, starting in June, to help you if needed. The housing buddy can attend viewings for you if you are not in the Netherlands and the landlord requires this. Furthermore, they can double-check your contract or assist you if you have any doubts about an offer, and you think it is a scam.
