Things to do in Hung Yen and surrounding area

Hanoi - the capital of Vietnam, known for its centuries-old architecture and a rich culture with Southeast Asian, Chinese and French influences. At its heart is the chaotic Old Quarter with narrow streets and many little temples.

Nom Ancient Village –one of the two most

ancient villages in Vietnam (ranked below Duong Lam village in Hanoi), it was the main supplier for bronze money and hardware casting's materials. Nom village has a picturesque layout comprising ponds, worshipping houses, and residential houses.

Hoàn Kiếm Lake - the lake is one of the major scenic spots in Hanoi and serves as a focal point for its public life.
