If you are selected for this opportunity by the Go Abroad team at University of Staffordshire, your exchange application to Eberhard Karls Universität Tübingen will need to be submitted as follows:

Application deadline Semester 1 – 16th May

Application deadline Semester 2 – 23rd October



Accommodation

The student dormitories are not administered by the University, but by "Studierendenwerk" (Housing - Studierendenwerk Tübingen-Hohenheim), the Student Service Organization, which is not affiliated with the University. However, the University of Tübingen has a yearly quota of rooms that are reserved for exchange students.
