Whether it's the motorbikes weaving through the narrow streets, or the exciting local food scene, exploring Hanoi will be a charming and lively experience!

Things to do in Hanoi

Hoan Kiem Lake – also known as Guom Lake, it is located in the heart of Hanoi. It is famous for its peaceful beauty, as well as its cultural and historical values.

Hanoi Cathedral – located in the city centre and neighbouring Hoan Kiem Lake, Hanoi Cathedral (or St. Joseph's Cathedral) is a beautiful and historic architecture with Gothic style. It remains a favourite spot for many with cafes and restaurants for visitors to enjoy!



Hanoi Train Street – a unique and popular attraction where trains pass closely by residential homes, creating an exhilarating experience for visitors and locals alike. This has been recognised as a way for tourists to experience the coming together between French and Vietnamese architecture, and also the local life of those that live along the railway.

Buses are the most common and accessible public transportation in Hanoi, with tickets costing around 9,000 VND (about 30p!). Apart from the peak hours, buses are quite empty and operate regularly. Keep some small banknotes ready and hop on the bus to get around to places like:

- Hoan Kiem Lake
- Dong Xuan Market
- O Quan Chuong Gate



Places to Visit near Hanoi

Ride-hailing services in Vietnam are very active. These services are highly trusted by locals as they save both costs and time compared to using a traditional taxi. In Hanoi, there are 3 different competitors operating: Grab, Gojek and Be. There are also others way to get around, including buses, shuttle buses, and trains.

Ha Long Bay – by shuttle bus it takes 2.5 hours and costs approx. £11

Quang Phu Cau Incense Village – it is about 1 hour drive south of Hanoi. Reviewers recommend taking a private/shared taxi to get there as public transport can take a long time.
