About Rena & Innlandet



Rena and the surrounding areas offer excellent conditions for a diverse outdoor life during both summer and winter. Rena campus offers creative academic communities and engaged students. Åmot municipality offers great arenas for leisure-time activities such as skiing and golfing. Innlandet offers everything from deep forests and rolling farmlands to dramatic mountains and

Things to do in Rena (& Innlandet County)

National Parks – Innlandet is home to some of Norway's most stunning national parks, each offering unique landscapes and outdoor experiences. Part of Jotunheimen National Park falls within Innlandet. The park is a paradise for hikers and mountaineers, boasting Norway's highest peaks.

Hafjell - in winter, the region transforms into a skiing paradise, with Hafjell among the top destinations for alpine and cross-country skiing.

Lake Mjøsa - those drawn to the water can enjoy fishing and canoeing

Places to Visit near Rena

Oslo - famous for its culture and museums, including the Munch Museum and Viking Ship Museum, its modern architecture, such as the Opera House, and its proximity to nature, with forested areas and the scenic Oslo Fjord.

Sälen, Sweden - home to four major ski resorts (Lindvallen, Högfjället, Tandådalen and Hundfjället), Sälen in western Sweden is a veritable skier's paradise, with over 100

individual pistes in total. Sälen also hosts the start of the annual Vasaloppet, the world's largest, longest and oldest cross-country ski race.

Lillehammer - a ski resort town in southern Norway. Its Maihaugen open-air museum displays buildings from the 1200s to the present. The nearby Norwegian Olympic Museum has exhibits chronicling Lillehammer's 1994 Winter Olympics and features a biathlon simulator. Lyngåsbakkene Ski Jumping Arena includes a chairlift with views over the park. North is the Lillehammer Olympic Bobsleigh and Luge Track.

Accommodation

Students are accommodated in fully furnished single rooms, which include utilities, an internet connection, a desk chair, a closet, a small table, and a single bed. All rooms have a shared kitchen and social area. Some rooms are equipped with a private bathroom. The monthly rent is approximately 354 EUR. All student homes have access to a laundry machine, dryer, storage space, and parking. International students may rent kitchen equipment and bed linen (known as a "Basic Start Kit") from the Student Welfare Organization (SINN) at reasonable prices.
