Accommodation

LPU's residential facility can house 25,000+ students on campus. The hostels are comfortable and affordable, with common areas that provide the perfect area to relax, socialise, study and learn. Students can choose from shared rooms or individual apartments.

Most students who attend LPU are living away from home, so the university has a support system in place to provide care if people are struggling. LPU also has certain facilities and services available at an extra charge, such as a gym, indoor stadium (for swimming, squash, etc.), a food hall, and an in-house laundry service.

However, it is advised to book the hostels at the earliest possible option, to avail facilities of your choice and to avoid last moment rush.
