## Accommodation

Student Housing Police Academy offers accommodation for international students on campus in a dormitory near the Academy. Due to the high number of international students, mostly shared rooms are available. There are rooms to be shared by two students. The monthly accommodation fee for a place in a shared room at the dormitory is about 6-7 Euros/day (approx. 3500 CZK/month).
