About Saint Louis Music Centre

Saint Louis is a music education institution and is attended by more than 1,800 students a year. It has a dedicated teaching staff of over 150 nationally and internationally established musicians, alongside professionals in the music, record production, concert and film sectors. With over 360 different courses, it is one of the most comprehensive music schools in Europe.

Saint Louis is located in the city centre of Rome, in a beautiful, alternative neighbourhood called **"Rione Monti"**. It is well-connected to the underground service (Metro B, Cavour Station) and close to Termini central station. The Institute is divided into 4 buildings that are all in walking distance from one another. In total, there are 51 multifunctional music rooms, and 4 recording studios, alongside a music agency, four recording labels, and national and international festivals and events worldwide.

About Rome

Rome's history spans nearly 3,000 years, making it one of the oldest continuously inhabited cities in Europe. The city is famous for its remarkable archaeological sites and monuments, including the Colosseum, the Roman Forum, and the Pantheon. It attracts visitors from all over the world who want to explore these sites, as well as **experiencing the country's cuisine** and atmosphere.

Things to do in Rome

Trevi Fountain – The Trevi Fountain is the largest Baroque fountain in **Rome and symbolises the city's** rich history. It is famous for the tradition of tossing coins into its waters, believed to ensure a return to Rome.

The Colosseum - an iconic symbol of ancient Rome, the Colosseum is renowned for its grandeur and historical significance as a venue for gladiator flights.

Lido di Ostia – bus approx. 1hr 20 mins costing approx. £7
