Accommodation

Santander offers a wide variety of flats for rent in the private sector, while the availability of places in Colegios Mayores, whether public or private, is more limited. In general, the supply of accommodation is greater for the first semester/full academic year than for the second semester. It should also be taken into account that Santander is a tourist city in summer, so it is strongly recommended to book your accommodation well in advance.
