Things to do in Wels

Ledererturm – This large tower is the last remnants of medieval Wels and the fortifications that used to surround the town.

Stadtplatz – The Stadtplatz is one of the main local areas in Wels. Lining the square are many different shops and cafes to enjoy.

Burg Wels – a Historic Medieval Castle in Austria, originally built by the early medieval inhabitants of the region.

Accommodation

The Wels campus has two housing options: Georg Oberhaidinger Haus and Kolpinghaus Wels.

Georg Oberhaidinger – The Heimbauverein is a recently built house for students in Wels. This accommodation offers space for 100 students and is only a few minutes' walk away from The University of Applied Sciences.

Students can choose between 2 types of housing:

- Single room with its own small kitchen, equipped with a hob, fridge and multifunction oven
- Single room in a shared apartment – 3 students live in their single rooms and share a fully equipped kitchen with dining area
