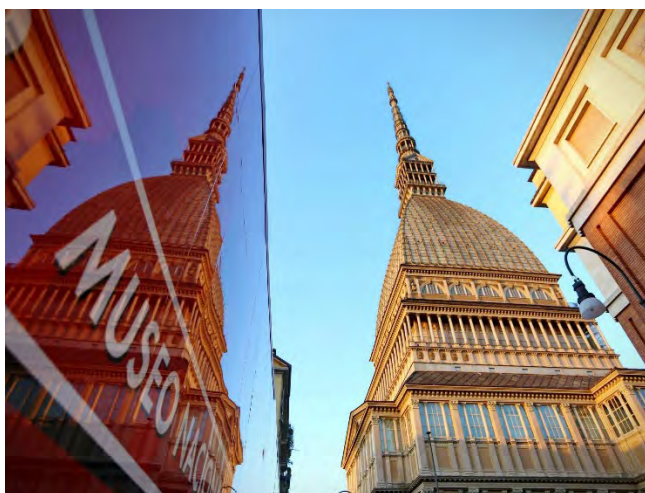

Palazzo Madama – a castle designed with a unique mix of Roman, Medieval and Baroque styles. It also houses the Turin City Museum of Ancient Art, exhibiting a vast collection of paintings, sculpture and ceramics.

Piazza San Carlo – this elegant square is lined with cafes and shops, making it a perfect spot for a leisurely stroll or a coffee break.
