Annexe A Outline of the Order of Decision Making

It is expected that the student will complete all assessments outlined on the module descriptor to complete outstanding modules and achieve the credit required for progression or awards (section 2).

Where this is not possible, an alternative assessment which complies with the principles outlined in this policy (Section 5.1) will be developed by the Course Team. This will be approved (section 5.3) and will provide the opportunity for the student to complete outstanding modules.

Where an alternative assessment is not possible, if the student has completed assessments totalling 66% of the module mark, the module will be treated as completed (section 2.1).


